A Fish Tale....

Actually it was 1,500 fish tails and they were all in the plane with me!

Recently I had the opportunity to make an unusual flight. I was asked to fly 1,500 Tilapia fish to an orphanage. The goal was to provide the children with a continual supply of food and much needed protein. Edsel Redden (pictured at the right) has a Tilapia ministry in Haiti. He takes fish from his breeding ponds to other locations. Tilapia are a fast growing and fast reproducing fish. Once the people are trained on the care and feeding of the fish, they will have a never-ending supply of food.



To keep the fish alive during the flight, they were put into three coolers with 12-volt aerators connected to a battery.



The fish are for an orphanage in Jeremie. In three months, the fish will be big enough to eat. Pictured above are the kids who met the plane and will benefit from the fish.



George is one of the orphans who has been praying hard for the fish to come. He was very excited when we arrived and was the first to take a close up look at the Tilapia. I hope they like fish.
