Furlough: Work or Vacation?

For every 3 1/2 years on the field with MAF we are given a 6 month furlough in the US. This is a time to raise needed funds, to report back to supporting individuals and churches and to REST from the various stresses experienced in a foreign country.

However, REST is sometimes hard to come by as the whole family is uprooted from home and traveling becomes the focus for half a year! Since December 1 the White family has packed and unpacked 19 different times and covered over 9,000 miles.

In January we flew to MAF's headquarters in CA, for a battery of medical exams, counseling sessions, and debriefing. February found us speaking every Sunday in NE. We started the month of March by being heavily involved in a missions conference in OK. We are finding REST a little elusive!

Traveling has been really hard on the kids. Having to sleep in different beds and constantly changing routines is not very comforting. William usually ends his day by saying, "I want to go home to Haiti".

Even if we are a bit RESTLESS it has been great to share the ministry of MAF in Haiti with so many of you. Will has a lot to report about all the flying he has done this past term. Most of it has been transporting Christian work teams from Port-au-Prince to the provinces of Haiti. The travel conditions there continue to deteriorate, along with security in the country. But even with these difficult times in Haiti, doctors, dentists, builders, teachers and other Christian workers continue to come to tell the Haitian people about Christ. MAF is there to provide transportation to their areas of ministry.

Below are some program statistics for our last term. Because of your prayers and financial support of our ministry with MAF, we are making an impact in Haiti!

- Total hours flown: **3,886**
- Landings made: **8,962**
- Passengers flown: **22,724**
- Pounds of cargo: **946,963**
- Aircraft inspections: **78**

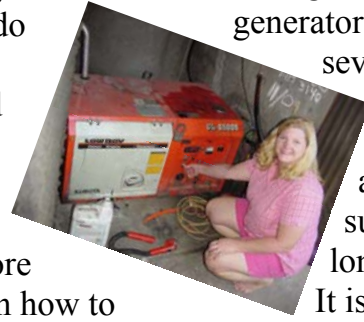
Support Report:

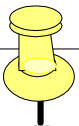

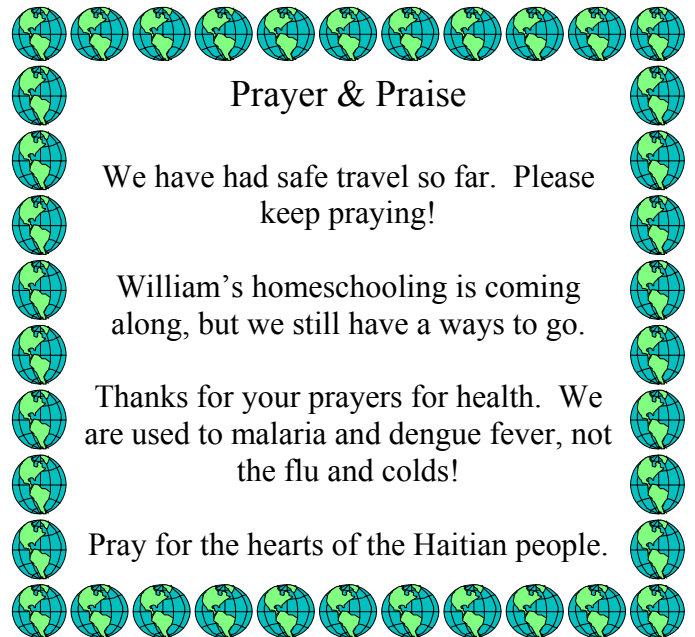
